Dear Students,

The Stewie Cruisers invite you to submit an application for a Stewie Cruisers Car Club Scholarship. The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage students to further their education in the automobile industry beyond high school by providing financial assistance.

Scholarships are made possible through funding raising events hosted by the Stewie Cruisers Car Club. Therefore, the amount of each scholarship as well as the number of scholarships awarded is determined annually.

All information an applicant provides is subject to verification. Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, religion, sex or national origin.

Eligibility:

1. Applicant/Student must have graduated from a school or registered home school within Southeastern Minnesota including the counties of Freeborn, Mower, Fillmore, Houston, Winona, Olmsted, Dodge, Steele, Rice, Goodhue, and Wabasha.
2. Student must have been accepted at a certified school for a two- or four-year program within the automotive field or in a vocational/technical program (including, but not limited to auto mechanics, auto body work, small business administration (for owning your own shop, parts store, etc.) to begin in the summer or fall following graduation from high school or registered home. The scholarship will be paid via check to the recipient's program or school in the recipient's name. The scholarship is renewable; however, it must be applied for each year and can be awarded to the same applicant twice during his/her tenure as a student.

Instructions:

1. Complete the attached application form and corresponding documents to the address above.
2. Submit a letter of recommendation from your automotive instructor or another instructor if your school does not have an automotive program.
3. Attach a copy of your letter of acceptance from the school or program you are planning to attend.
4. Submit a copy of your transcripts.

5. Demonstrate financial need as determined by the FAFSA Federal Student Aid Application. (attached)

Deadline: Application must be postmarked by March 15 of current year.
